Digging for Victory is the order of the day. Everybody who is able secures an allotment or a plot of land. The potato is one of the staple foodstuffs of the country. Grow as many as you can, not only because they will be dear to buy, but because by doing so you will be increasing the home supply. It is impossible to fix an exact date for planting, so much depends upon the ground and the weather; generally speaking, the best time is between the middle of March and the middle of this month. It is possible to grow a crop on the same ground every year, but a change of ground is preferable. It is better to buy your seed that has been grown in another district. The ground should be fertilized by the use of well-rotted farmyard manure excellent results are to be obtained with chemical manures. The distance apart will depend upon the soil and the variety of the seed chosen; it is, however, a mistake to plant too closely.

Main crop Carrots and Beetroot should be sown this month; the latter is best sown at the end of the month. The leek is a very useful vegetable and more easily grown than the onion. Seeds of the Leek should be sown now for transplanting in June or July. The best way to transplant is to draw drills and with a make holes 10 in. apart, fill the holes with water which quickly drains away, and drop a seedling into each hole. This is an easy way of blanching the Leek, without the trouble of earthing up.
